## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

CDC operates 7:00 am to 6:00 pm in the Louis V. Schuldt building and multiple classrooms in the leading Club. Assistants are responsible for the day-to-day safety and supervision of the preschool-age children enrolled in the CDC program. This includes planning and leading quiet games, arts & crafts, academics, drama, sports, and/or other activities that interest children.

## **JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Provide high-quality care, enrichment, and recreation for preschool-age children enrolled in the CDC programs.
- Plan developmentally appropriate activities for the CDC programs.
- Provide a nurturing environment in which children can grow and develop.
- Provide the **DIRECT SUPERVISION AND SAFETY** of the CDC children at all times. Follow all the Child Care Division Rules & Regulations

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

CDC assistants should have one year of college with an emphasis in child development, education, recreation, or a related field, OR at least one-year full-time experience working with preschool-age children in an organized and ongoing group setting (i.e., classroom, kindergarten, preschool age child care, recreation program or comparable setting). CDC Assistants must have a current CPR & First Aid Certificate, Online Childcare Health and Safety Training, and be a member of the State Child-care Registry with a current fingerprint on file.
